The first edition of the BAUHAUS4EU PhD Hackathon took place at the University of Economics in Katowice from July 6-9. During the four-day event, **doctoral students** worked on selected research topics, seeking **creative and innovative solutions**. Participants gave very positive feedback on the event, emphasizing the importance of teamwork, diverse perspectives, and the opportunity to develop **research ideas jointly**. BIPs at UPCB brought 40 students from the Alliance

Polytechnic University of Castelo Branco (UPCB) held four Blended Intensive Programmes (BIPs) in May and June, bringing together several **students from partner universities** of the BAUHAUS4EU Alliance. Among the 108 students who participated in the BIPs, 16 were from the University of Bergamo (Italy), 13 from POLIS University (Albania), 7 from Université Lumière Lyon 2 (France), 3 from Université de Picardie Jules Verne (France), and 1 from Bauhaus-Universität Weimar (Germany).
